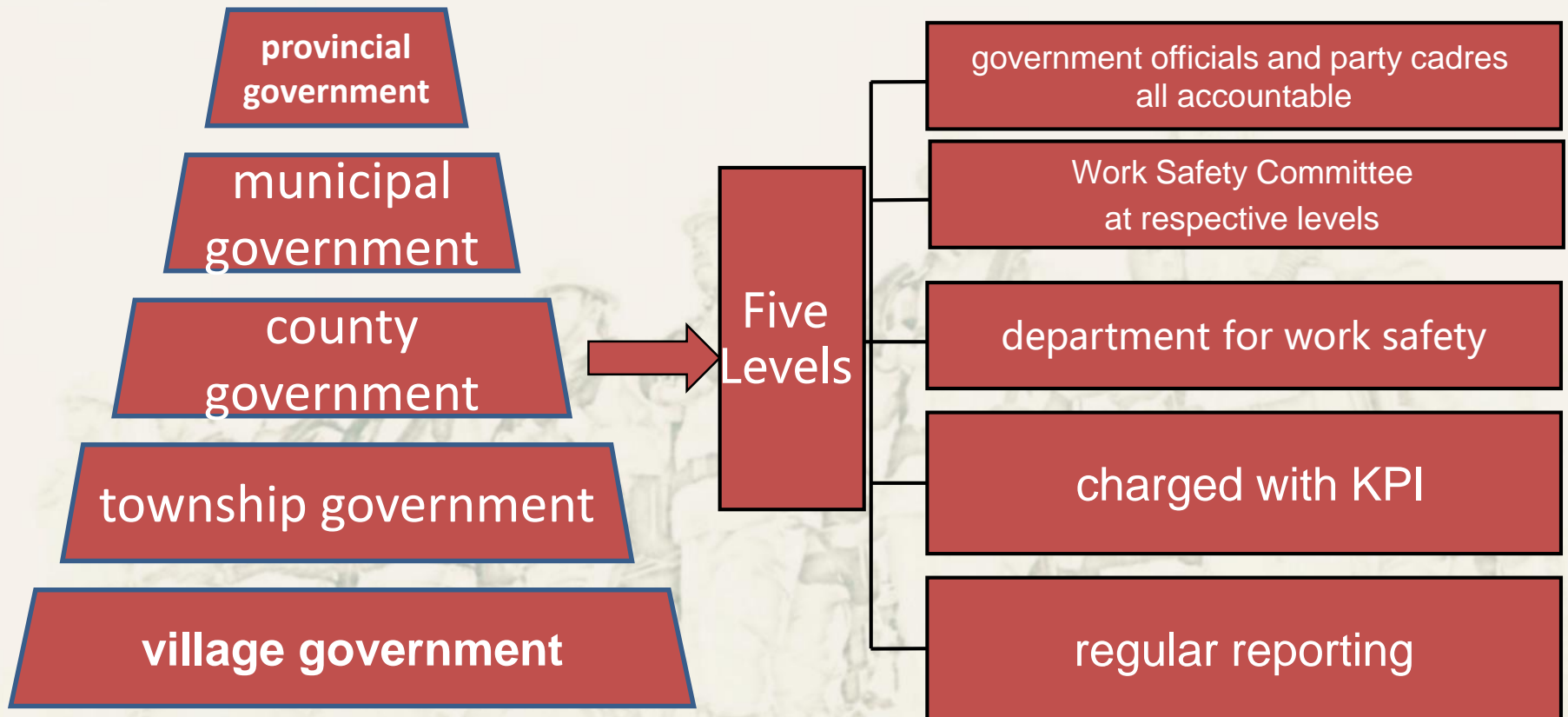


Work Safety Responsibility System

Chinese government has requested such system be established in five levels of administrative hierarchy, namely, provincial, municipal, county, township and village government. The Party Secretary at the five levels and the administrative head of each of the five levels of the governments should take up the same responsibility for work safety. As for any official, apart from what you are assigned for, you should also see to it that work safety be ensured.

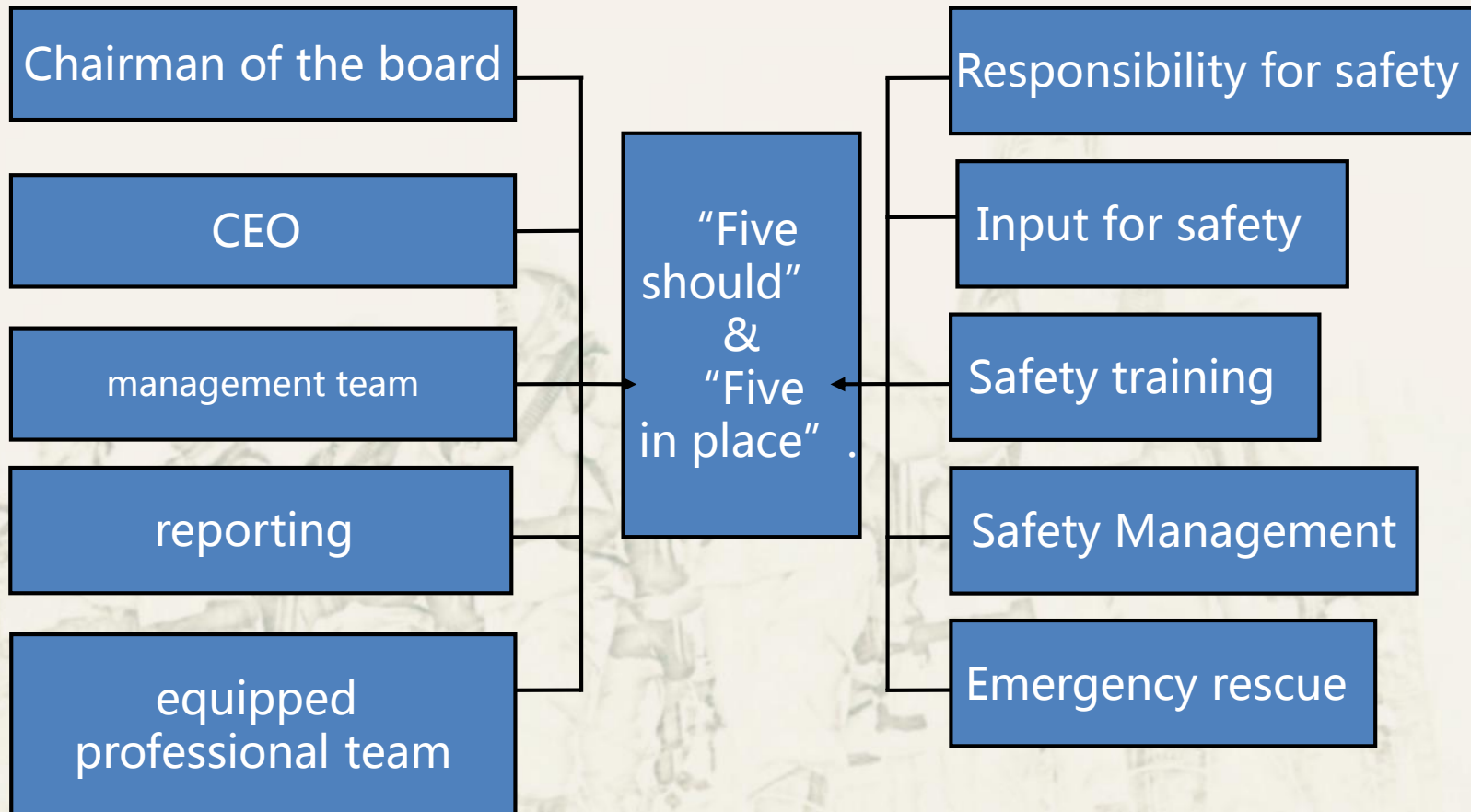

- Established 7 national level mine rescue teams based on the major state-owned coal mining enterprises



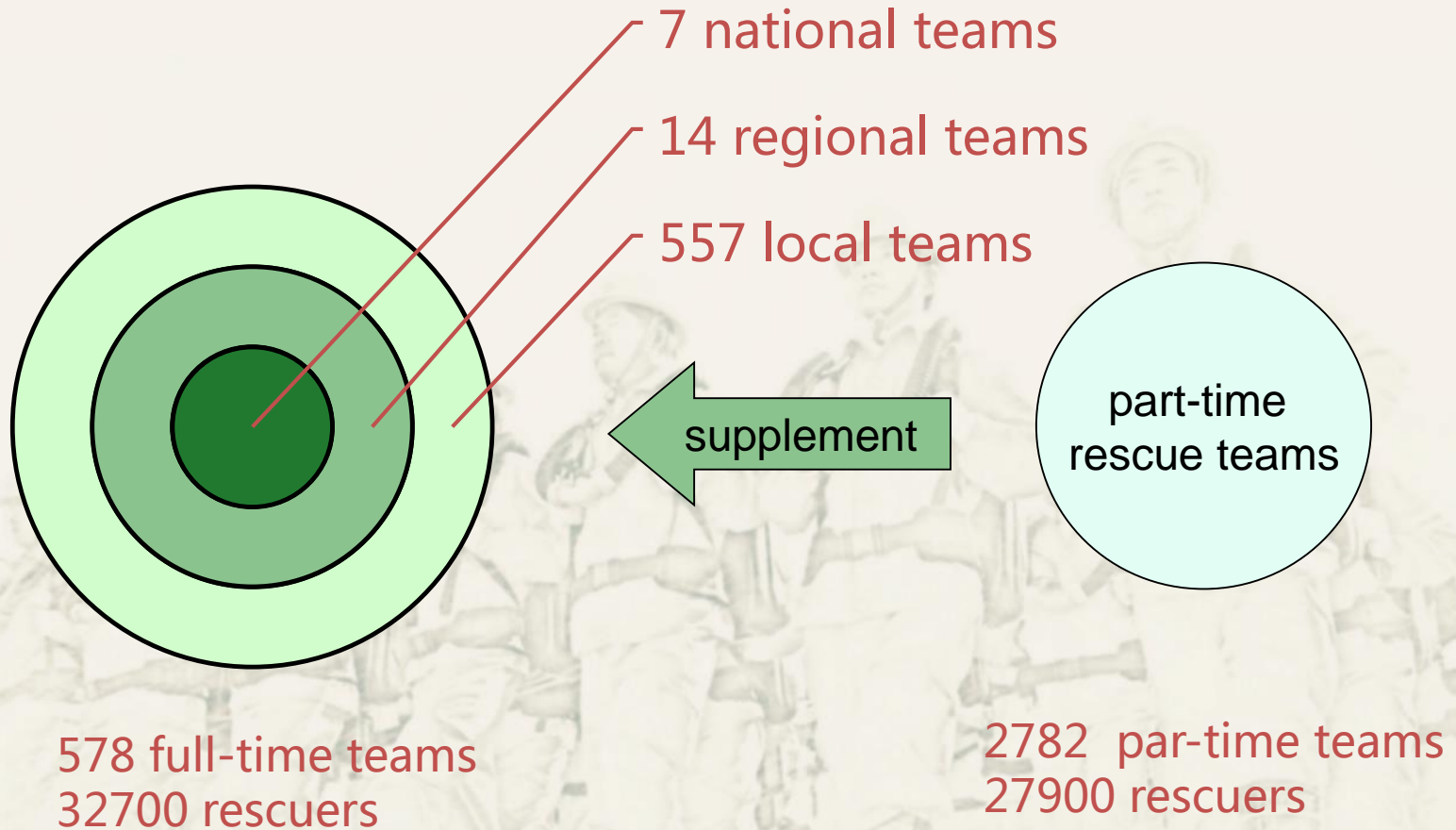

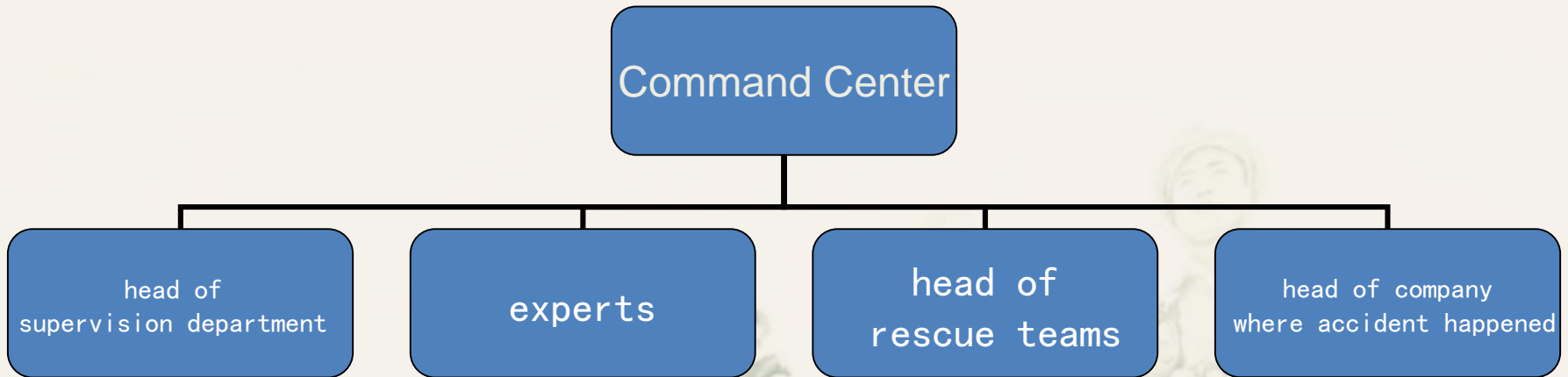
Continuous Improvement of Management on Accident Scene



clear responsibility and coordination



Continuous Improvement of Management on Accident Scene



- The Director General for rescue operation is authorized with full power for on-site command
- The DG leads the unified making of on-site response plans, command the on-site emergency response operation, and organize relevant departments to the site for emergency response
- Local government issues decision to transfer and expropriate emergency response assets, the DG is then authorized to carry out that decision
- The DG is responsible for keeping good orders on accident scene and organizing people to comfort those who lost their relatives in accidents
- The DG may publicize information related to the accident
